CHECK WITH YOUR HEALTH CENTRE

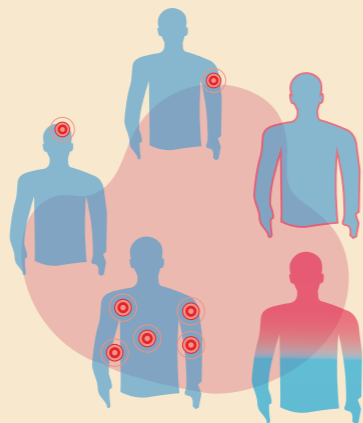
- If you have any queries about whether you should be vaccinated, the place, the group you belong to, order of vaccination, etc.



CAN IT CAUSE ADVERSE OR SIDE EFFECTS?






Yes, similar to those of any other medication:

- Soreness or swelling at the point of injection.
- Tiredness.
- Headache.
- Muscle pain.
- Fever.



BEFORE, DURING AND AFTER VACCINATION:

Keep up with prevention measures:

- Face mask. 
- Hand washing. 
- Social distancing. 
- Limited interaction with other people. 
- Activities outdoors or in well-ventilated places. 

IF YOU HAVE A REACTION

Seek medical care at your health centre or hospital.

Reporting any reactions is important so that they can be recorded and analysed.
